Purchasing Reminders

At Station Booths:

- \$1 fee applies to each new MetroCard purchase. Fee does not apply to card refills or Reduced-Fare MetroCards.
- New Pay-Per-Ride MetroCard minimum purchase is \$5.50; \$80 maximum purchase.
- \$50 bills accepted on purchases of \$30 or more.
- \$100 bills accepted on purchases of \$70 or more.

At Vending Machines (MVMs):

- \$1 fee applies to each new MetroCard purchase. Fee does not apply to card refills or Reduced-Fare MetroCards.
- MVMs accept only \$1, \$5, \$10, \$20 or \$50 bills. No \$100 bills.
- No pennies; nickel increments only.
- MVMs dispense up to \$9 in change.

Pre-Valued MetroCards Sold Only at Merchants

For your convenience, get the exact number of rides you need plus the 11% bonus with **no remaining balances** at participating merchants around the city:

If you ride the subway and/or local buses:

| Buy a \$9.91 MetroCard (\$11.00 value) | Get 4 rides |

Unlimited Ride MetroCard Grace Period and Refunds

All Unlimited Ride MetroCards purchased prior to the March 22, 2015 fare change must be activated by **March 29, 2015** to get the full days of unlimited rides.

For purchases made before the March 22, 2015 fare change:

- 2. Used Unlimited Ride MetroCards: refunds made on a pro-rated basis.
